Autumn math garland – Instruction and DOWNLOAD!

I always associate autumn with math. There are so many of its attributes that we can count: chestnuts, acorns, nuts, leaves ...

I am sure that in our home there will be a lot of activities related to counting, so this garland will be our error control, on which children will

be able to easily check how many objects are, for example, five.

What will we need?

- Printed garland
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Hooks
- String

## My tips:

It is good to print it on harder, thicker paper so that you do not have to laminate it, and thus produce another plastic. I use the services of a local printing house because my printer likes to play tricks at home;)

Attach the hooks to the wall, thread the garland pieces together onto a string and attach them to the hooks.

Individual elements can also be attached to a string with clothespins.

We hang the garland in one or two rows - depending on how much space we have.

At the beginning, you don't have to hang everything, just a few introductory cards, e.g. 1-3. As the child understands the next stages, you can increase the number of elements or exchange numbers.
